100% Nebbiolo. Elegant and structured with aromas of rose petals, red cherry, and dried herbs. The palate shows fine tannins, bright acidity, and layers of raspberry, spice, and subtle earth, leading to a long, refined finish.

94% Tinto Fino, 6% Cabernet Sauvignon. Incredibly floral and beautiful with dark berry, cedar and Chinese plums, Asian spices create a full body, dense with a soft and complex background.
- 204** **2016 OPUS ONE, Rothschild x Mondavi, Napa Valley, California, USA** **790**
80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Petit Verdot, 6% Cabernet Franc, 5% Merlot, 2% Malbec. 18 months in new French oak - a concentrated blend of red cherry, blackberry and black currant offers a velvety texture and complex structure that builds to a long, vibrantly fresh finish.
- 221** **1997 CHÂTEAU MOUTON ROTHSCHILD, 1^{ER} G.C.C., Pauillac, Bordeaux, France** **940**
82% Cabernet Sauvignon, 13% Merlot, 3% Cabernet Franc, and 2% Petit Verdot. Medium-bodied, it offers a round, fruity with fine tannins.
- 443** **2001 PENFOLDS GRANGE, Barossa Valley, South Australia** **1,070**
97% Shiraz/Syrah and 3% Cabernet Sauvignon - Aged for 17 months in new American oak. The structure is robust, rich and full-bodied.
- 220** **1994 CHÂTEAU LATOUR, Premier Grand Cru Classé, Pauillac, Bordeaux, France** **1,625**
68% Cabernet Sauvignon, 27% Merlot, 4% Cabernet Franc, and 1% Petit Verdot. A full body with well-structured, lengthy finish and sweet tannins.
- 208** **1981 PETRVS, Grand Vin, Pomerol, Bordeaux, France** **2,850**
96% Merlot, 4% Cabernet Franc. A legendary wine from this iconic Pomerol estate.

66% Chardonnay, 34% Pinot Noir

453 2024 'WIGGLE BUM', Break Free Natural Wines, McLaren Vale, South Australia 73
100% Grenache Blanc. An array of, apple, pear, white peach, and lime zest, with gentle honeysuckle and spice, adding perfumed floral aromatics to create distinctive and unique varietal flavours.

444 2019 CHARDONNAY, Curly Flat, Victoria, Australia 145
100% Chardonnay - Aged in French oak barrels for 14 months. Notes of lemon & lime zest with white peach & nectarine stone fruits with minerality.

Punchy tropical fruit on the nose, the palate balances the pure, fresh flavours of apple, pineapple and melon with mouth-watering minerality and a zingy acidity.

Beautiful aromas of gooseberry, kaffir lime, apricot and lemon peel, leading to a delightfully flavoursome palate of excellent fruit intensity and vibrant acidity.
- 151** **2017 CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET, Les Macherelles, Guy Amiot et Fils, Burgundy, France** **32**
100% Chardonnay. Aromas of ripe orchard fruits, citrus zest, and white blossom with a hint of toasted oak. On the palate it is elegant and layered, showing fresh stone fruit and lemon, balanced by a subtle creaminess.

- 425** **2024 LA SANGLIÈRE, Vertu de Sanglière Rosé, AOP Côtes de Provence, France** **16**
Cinsault 60%, Grenache 40%. Aromas of yellow fruits and spices. On the palate, it is round and captivating, with a mineral freshness reminiscent of its terroir. The length is pleasant, with notes of peach and fresh fruit.

RED

- 79** **2017 MERCUREY 1ER CRU LES PUILLETS, Château de Chamilly, Burgundy, France** **15**
100% Pinot Noir. An overt and aromatic bouquet with notes of ripe black cherries and a hint of hedgerow. The palate is ripe, rich and finely textured with bramble and damson fruits and an underlying cherry stone freshness.
- 401** **2024 MENCIA, Ribas Del Cúa, Joven, Bierzo, Spain** **16**
On the nose it offers great aromatic intensity, dominated by raspberries, cassis, currant and black fruits like blackberry and cherry. On the palate it is fresh, balanced, unctuous and long.

100% Viognier. Fermented in stainless steel and aged for 11 months in a mixture of stainless steel and oak, creating a deliciously aromatic wine with a creamy texture with complex stone fruit and floral notes.

Beautiful Montrachet style. Lick of vanilla and stones on the nose, with lime and spice, and lovely oak, from the 10 months in barrel.

100% Savagnin. Opens with aromas of walnut, toasted hazelnut, saffron and dried citrus. The palate is powerful yet vibrant, showing nutty depth, gentle spice and dried fruit complexity, finishing long, saline and beautifully persistent.

100% Chardonnay. 80% was fermented in steel tank to give a rich and powerful aroma, with a strong mineral palate.

100% Chardonnay. With fruit aromas and overtones of honey, a balance of minerals and lime.
- 47 2022 LILIUM, Château Climens, Bordeaux, France 165**
100% Sémillon. Offering notes of ripe apricots and peaches, orange, quince and yellow apple which is complemented by a clear, precise but soft acidity balancing the wine impressively and leading to a long finish.
- 482 2021 'WHITE BONES' CHARDONNAY, Bodega Catena Zapata, Mendoza, Argentina 205**
Flavours of crisp green apple, Meyer lemon, and white peach with an undertone of vibrant acidity that imparts freshness and vitality, with the use of French oak barrels contributes a subtle creaminess and notes of vanilla - dubbed the Grand Cru of South America.

- 421 2022 DIAMANTOPETRA ROSE, Diamantakis, Crete, Greece 69**
100% Liatiko. Fermented in stainless steel tanks to produce a wonderfully refreshing wine which balances delicate strawberry fruit with sour cherry and hints of spice.
- 395 2022 PRÉCOCE ROSÉ, Dunesforde, York, North Yorkshire, England 77**
100% Pinot Précoce. Light and dry, this still rosé displays vibrant summer fruits on the palate with a long, succulent finish.
- 64 2023 IL ROSATO, Nervi Conterno, Piedmont, Italy 83**
100% Nebbiolo. Aromas of fresh red berries, citrus, and subtle herbs. Crisp and lively on the palate, with bright fruit, minerality, and a refined, creamy texture from extended lees ageing. A vibrant, terroir-driven rosé from a legendary producer.
- 60 2024 CLOSE MIREILLE ROSÉ, Domaine Ott, AOC Côtes de Provence, France 116**
63% Grenache, 20% Cinsault, 12% Syrah, 5% Rolle. A pale pink hue, with aromas of citrus and pineapple, rich in flavours of fresh red fruits.
- 163 2018 CHATEAU MUSAR ROSÉ, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon 130**
57% Obaideh, 40% Merwah, and 3% Cinsault. Aromas of raspberries and soft red berry fruits with citrus notes of tangerine and caramelised orange. On the palate there is spiced orange, raspberries and a hint of vanilla from the 9 months barrel ageing.
- 88 2022 GARRUS, Château d'Esclans, Provence, France 205**
A blend of old-vine Grenache and Vermentino. Concentrated aromas and flavours of dried citrus, peaches and passion fruit. A bright acidity with glazed pear and pineapple filling the mid palate. A long creamy finish that features rich, spicy notes. A true icon in the world of rosé.
