WHITES

- 166 2021 COROA D'OURO BRANCO, Poças, Douro Valley, Portugal** £44
30% Códega, 20% Malvasia Fina, 20% Rabigato, 20% Viosinho, 10% Moscatel Galego Branco. Soft, fruity and aromatic, with apricot and green plum
- 381 2021 ALTOS LOS ROMEROS, Colchagua Valley, Chile** £46
63% Roussanne, 37% Marsanne. Aromas of mandarin orange, orange peel, honey and hazelnuts and freshness from the Roussanne and some richness and weight from the unctuous Marsanne.
- 87 2010 CORTON-CHARLEMAGNE, Grand Cru, Domaine Louis Latour, Burgundy, France** £600
100% Chardonnay. Aged 8 to 10 months in 100% new oak barrels. Full-bodied, rich and flavourful with ripen tropical fruit, grilled almonds and vanilla. Round in the mouth with integrated oak, refreshing acidity and a long, mineral finish.

REDS

- 164 2015 BARON GUSTAV VON FÜSTENBERG, Q De Sant'Ana, Mafra, Lisboa, Portugal** £120
58% Merlot, 42% Touriga Nacional. Cassis, violets and blackcurrants alongside green bell pepper and earthy pine forests. Balanced integrated oak and tannins, with a backbone of acidity that keeps this wine lifted and promises to do so for a long while.
- 209 2007 CHÂTEAU CERTAN DE MAY, Pomerol, Bordeaux, France** £228
70% Merlot , 25% Cabernet Franc, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon . Located on Pomerol's prized central plateau, opposite Le Pin and next to Pétrus. Opaque,Medium red-ruby colour. Complex nose of cherries and ripe plum perfume, the palate is quite gorgeous with flavors of blueberry, redcurrant, tobacco, mocha, and licorice. Finishes with a firm tannic spine that calls for several years of cellaring.
- 59 1995 GASSAC ROUGE, Mas De Daumas Gassac, Languedoc, France** £250
68% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Syrah, 7% Cabernet Franc, 6.5% Merlot, 6% Malbec, 2% Pinot noir, 1.5% Tannat, 1% other rare varietals. With age, this wine develops burgundy characters of truffles. A truly vigorous, opulent wine! Abundant in character but nothing in excess. The fruit, the velvety texture and alcohol are perfectly balanced.
- 226 1993 CHÂTEAU MARGAUX, 1er Grand Cru Classé, Margaux, France** £960
75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot, 5% Petit verdot. Medium to deep, dark ruby-red colour. Cedarwood and redcurrant notes on the nose. Fruity on the palate with savoury and gamy notes with oak characters following through to the finish showing elegant structure and clean acidity.

Flavourful with dark fruit, balsamic, cherry-liquor, cocoa, wood and herbal notes. Fine grained tannins,velvety texture and fresh acidity finish.

62% Pinot Noir, 38% Chardonnay.Full roasted nuts and brioche notes on the nose, with concentrated weight on the palate. Savoury and fresh finish.

- 33 2022 PÉT-NAT, Bliss Bomb, Break Free, Swan Valley, Western Australia** £68
100% Chenin Blanc. A refreshing and effervescent sparkling wine with aromatic notes of ginger and lemongrass. Its bright, while the fresh palate reveals a harmonious blend of apples, pears, and citrus blossoms.
- 35 2015, Cava Brut Real Gran Reserva, Mastinell, Vilafranca del Penedès, Spain** £76
40% Macabeo, 40% Xarel-lo de Olérdola, and 20% Parellada de Sant Martí. 30 months in bottle. This wine presents a vibrant golden hue, adorned with delicate, fine bubbles. The aroma is profoundly floral, featuring subtle notes of apple, ripe pear, and anise. On the palate, it is beautifully balanced, exuding elegance and harmony. The finish is long and refreshing, with delightful hints of citrus fruit and a gentle touch of fennel.
- 30 2019, QUEEN OF THE NORTH, Upper Duneforth, North Yorkshire, England** £140
70% Chardonnay, 30% Pinot Noir. fourteen months on lees. Finesse, elegance followed by ripe fruit, light yeast aromas and a smooth, creamy complexity.
- 32 2014, JUBILEE CUVÉE 1952, Brut, Breaky Bottom, East Sussex, England** £145
70% Chardonnay, 15% Pinot Noir, 15% Pinot Meunier. Aged for seven years on the lees in ancient pure chalk soils, this classic blend offers a fine mousse, some inviting aromas of soft fruits, and warm brioche notes followed by a refreshing acidity complemented by an elegant finish
- 31 2020, PINOT GRIS, Upper Duneforth, North Yorkshire, England** £160
A delicate sparkling wine with a crisp freshness followed by ripe orchard fruits, Bursting on the palate.

CHAMPAGNES

- 1 NV, CHAMPAGNE LOUIS ROEDERER, Collection 244, Reims, France** £130
41% Chardonnay, 33% Pinot Noir, 26% Pinot Meunier. Deep bouquet of ripe wild peaches and pears combined with lemons and blood oranges. The palate is showing a rich and robust texture with smoky notes.
- 5 NV, CHAMPAGNE GUY DE CHASSEY, Grand Cru Brut, Louvois, France** £135
70% Pinot Noir and 30% Chardonnay. A combination of young & old vine fruits. Youthful citrus zest alongside toasted brioche notes & cinnamon spice.
- 2 NV, CHAMPAGNE J.M LABRUYERE, Prologue, Brut, Verzenay, France** £140
69 % Pinot noir, 31 % Chardonnay, A fine textured wine, fruity, generous with notes of small red fruits and minerals. The Palate is rich with pastry notes, red berries, white and citrus fruits.
- 3 NV, CHAMPAGNE GARDET, Brut Rosé, Chigny-Les-Roses, France** £148
45% Pinot Noir, 45% Pinot Meunier, 10% Chardonnay. Ripe strawberry, summer berry and citrus flavours with a crisp steely acidity and a refreshing finish.
- 4 2016, CHAMPAGNE PLOYER-JACQUEMART, Blanc De Noir, Extra Brut, Ludes, France** £226
50% Pinot Noir, 50% Pinot Meunier. The nose is complex and reveals notes of black fruits. The perfect balance between freshness and deep intensity.
- 18 NV, CHAMPAGNE DELAMOTTE, Blanc De Blanc, Brut, Le Mesnil-Sur-Oger, France** £215
100% Chardonnay. Aromas of citrus with hints of ginger with a creamy mousse and some citrus and vanilla leading to a long finish with great acidity.
- 6 NV, CHAMPAGNE BILLECART-SALMON, Brut Rosé, Mareuil Sur Aÿ, France** £265
40% Chardonnay, 30% Pinot Noir, 30% Meunier, Inc. 10% Red Wine. Persistent mousse with red fruits and hints of citrus aromas. Delicate flavours of strawberries, raspberries and brioche with red berries and citrus finish.
- 7 2012, CHAMPAGNE BOLLINGER, La Grande Année, Brut, Ay, France** £470
65% Pinot Noir, 35% Chardonnay. Aged 7 years on the lees. The bouquet opens with aromas of almonds and succulent tropical fruits like mango, intertwined with zesty citrus hints and grapefruit essence. As it touches the tongue, the citrus notes persist, paving the way for luscious honeyed tones and a lingering, invigorating finish. This sparkling wine exhibits excellent aging potential.
- 9 2012, CHAMPAGNE CRISTAL, LOUIS ROEDERER, Brut, Reims, France** £750
60% Pinot Noir, 40% Chardonnay, aged 9 years on the lees. Rich and aromatic with notes of zesty and candied lemons, white flowers, roasted hazelnut, vanilla, brioche and smoky notes from bottle ageing followed by a slightly chalky palate and a mouth-coating texture.
- 8 2012, CHAMPAGNE SALON, Brut, Le Mesnil-Sur-Oger, France** £1,960
100% Chardonnay, aged for 8 years on the lees. 43rd Salon to be released, it is quite delicate with hint of pastry, jasmine and citrus scents, followed by a creamy palate and chalky characters. Dry with some minerality, fine bubbles and an extreme long-lasting finish.

WHITE WINES

- 191 2023 MAS OLIVERAS, Catalunya, Spain** £42
80% Macabeo (Viura), 20% Chardonnay. This wine offers an aromatic bouquet with white flower notes, leading to a light, floral palate. The taste profile features sweet peach and grapefruit flavors, culminating in a crisp finish marked by zesty citrus acidity.
- 482 2022 VINUL VERII, Călușari, Cramele Recas Estate, Romania** £46
68% Riesling, 29% Mustoasa de Maderat, 3% Feteasca Regala. Bright, fresh and packed with floral, citrus and green tea notes; delightfully easy drinking and packed with gooseberry, ripe pear and orchard fruits, with a lovely textural citrus finish.
- 305 2022 VERDICCHIO, Dei Castelli di Jesi, Pontemagno, Marche, Italy** £48
This wine features a delicate, perfumed aroma with hints of almond. It boasts an appealing acidity that balances beautifully with notes of lemon. The creamy texture complements its savoury character, leading to a crisp, citrusy finish. A great alternative to Pinot Grigio.
- 336 2022 SAUVIGNON BLANC, Lofthouse, Marlborough, New Zealand** £52
This wine has a zesty nettle and bright citrus notes with layers of green bell pepper, fresh-cut grass, lime, gooseberry, tropical fruits characters followed by a lovely crisp and fresh acidity.
- 193 N.V CUVÉE TOBIA BLANCO, Rioja Alta, Spain** £54
28% Sauvignon Blanc, 26% Tempranillo Blanco, 22% Chardonnay, 18% Viura, 4% Maturana Blanca, 2% Garnacha Blanca. Floral notes such as orange blossom and menthol, with hints of pear, tangerine, pineapple, banana and fruit of the passion honey, toffee and spices like cinnamon and vanilla
- 151 2022 SAUVIGNON BLANC, Mont de Joie** £56
Much of the fruit in this Sauvignon Blanc is sourced from the Sancerre region, sharing many of its characteristics the wine has delicate aromas and flavours of citrus, pear, and gooseberry, with bright notes of minerality.
- 470 2022 MALAGOUZIA, Kalogeri, Domaine Papagiannakos, Greece** £58
Aromas of ripe peaches and apricots on the nose with a soft and rounded palate full of ripe stone fruit, followed by hints of apple and pineapple. Fresh with a long lasting finish.
- 270 2021 RIESLING, Réserve, Domaine Jean Sipp, Alsace, France** £65
Apples, citrus and hints of anise on the nose, the palate is medium bodied with spice, honey and stone fruits, with a crisp finish.
- 165 2022 ALVARINHO, Vinho Verde DOC, Quinta D'Amares, Braga, Portugal** £67
Refreshing citrus, with lemon nuances and tropical fruits with a touch of tangerine and floral notes. A rich structure in the mouth, balanced with prolonged freshness.
- 272 2022 PINOT GRIS, Domaine Jean Sipp, Alsace, France** £70
A nose of confit pears, blossom and spice, notably vanilla. The wine is rich and powerful with baked apple, pear and spice and a fresh acidity.
- 157 2022 SANCERRE, Domaine de la Grande Maison, Chaumeau-Balland, Loire, France** £72
A classic Sauvignon blanc made in Bué, from 30 years old vignes. Lots of grapefruit, grassy, flinty and gooseberry notes.

- 271 2021 GEWÜRZTRAMINER, Domaine Jean Sipp, Alsace, France** £72
Floral nose with notes of rose petal, and candied apricot. Rich and spicy on the palate, with great intensity of fruit, fine acidity and an off-dry finish.
- 75 2020 MÂCON, La Roche Vineuse, Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Merlin, Burgundy, France** £74
100% Chardonnay. Fifteen Percent is fermented in old oak barrels to give the wine some richness while the majority is fermented in stainless steel. An underlying buttery and creaminess with a refreshing citrus finish.
- 295 2021 GRÜNER VELTLINER, Alte Reben, Sohm & Kracher, Austria** £82
Hints of bittersweet characters with, yellow apple, almond and grapefruit followed by refreshing flavours of oranges, pear and spicy white pepper on the finish.
- 45 2021 SOLARIS, Upper Dunsforth, York, North Yorkshire, England** £86
A fruity and aromatic aromas like hazelnuts and bananas with balance and a refreshing gooseberry style acidity.
- 47 2022 BACCHUS, Upper Dunsforth, York, North Yorkshire, England** £86
Perfectly balanced with sauvignon style with elderflower notes, citrus fruit flavours alongside a gooseberry crisp acidity
- 92 2022 CHABLIS, Domaine Dampt & Fils, Burgundy, France** £96
100% Chardonnay. Crafted from 45-year-old vines, this wine exemplifies classic Chablis. It showcases a well-defined palate of tropical fruits, complemented by a steely, tight, and lean structure. The delightful citrus acidity adds a wonderful balance, making it a truly remarkable offering
- 73 2020 VIOGNIER, ÔMAR, Jules Desjournays, Burgundy, France** £104
Complex yet harmonious aromas of orange blossom, pear, and passion fruit blend with zesty lemon, creating a rich, glyceric texture complemented by a subtle touch of oak.
- 201 2017 L'ESPRIT DE CHEVALIER, Grand Vin de Graves, Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux, France** £108
55% Sauvignon Blanc, 45% Sémillon. Notes of mandarin peel, fresh lemons, pink grapefruits and lime zest with green apple and a lively acidity.
- 201 2017 L'ESPRIT DE CHEVALIER, Grand Vin de Graves, Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux, France** £108
55% Sauvignon Blanc, 45% Sémillon. Notes of mandarin peel, fresh lemons, pink grapefruits and lime zest with green apple and a lively acidity.
- 71 2019 MACON-VERZÉ, Jules Desjournays, Burgundy, France** £135
100% Chardonnay. Aromas of crisp green apple, white flowers and ripe lemon. Grapefruit, pear and pineapple fruit on the palate.
- 91 2020 CHABLIS, 1er Cru Montée de Tonnerre, Domaine Testut, Burgundy, France** £154
100% Chardonnay. The most prestigious 1er Cru, located on the right bank of the Serein river, south-west facing and not far from the Grand Crus. The uncloned vines of this 1 ha vineyard plot are over 60 years old - The bouquet is complex and fuller, with layers of green apple, yeast, citrus acidity and wet-stones minerality.
- 72 2014 CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET, "Vieilles Vignes", Guy Amiot et Fils, Burgundy, France.** £158
100% Chardonnay. 40-90 year vines. This is a wine of great complexity with, white stone fruits, pear, pineapple, honey, citrus, spice, toasted oak and a buttery long-lasting, refreshing minerality.

WHITE WINES

- 85 2017 MEURSAULT, Domaine Michelot, Burgundy, France** £220
100% Chardonnay. The nose is rich with yellow fruit aromas and overtones of honey. The palate has pastry, honey, minerals and lime.
- 40 2018 MEUNIER, Blanc De Noir, Extra Brut, Ployez-Jacquemart, Ludes, France** £226
Fermented in tank and aged in Meursault barrels for a year, before bottling the wine in late 2021. The bouquet is deep and refined with apple, white peach and Meunier floral tones. The palate is complex with some minerality and a zesty finish.
- 90 2018 CHABLIS, Grand Cru Grenouille, Domaine Testut, Burgundy, France** £230
100% Chardonnay. A small plot of only 0.31 ha planted with 53-year-old uncloned vines. 80% was fermented in steel tank with the remaining 20% in 600 litre oak barrels. Rich and powerful aromas, with a strong mineral palate balanced with ripe white stone fruits and overtones of honeycomb and butter.
- 70 2012 BÂTARD-MONTRACHET, Grand Cru, Domaine Leflaivre, Burgundy, France** £915
100% Chardonnay. The bouquet has saltiness and minerality, while the palate is very well-balanced with crisp acidity and a little finesse and a hint of spice that becomes more accentuated with time.

ROSÉ WINES

- 420 2022 Syrah Rosé, Intipalka, Viñas Queirolo, Ica Valley, Peru** £46
standing out. The palate is well balanced with notes of ripe red fruits and a persistent, fresh and fruity finish with a slight saline character imparted by the Pacific Ocean just 60km away.
- 395 2023 CABERNET-FRANC ROSÉ, Cada Nube, Mendoza, Argentina** £58
Hints of fresh fruits like, wild strawberries, pink grapefruit, raspberries and some sea minerals with a freshness and acidity completing the richness on the palate.
- 60 2022 Clos Mireille Rosé, Domaines Ott, AOC Côtes de Provence, France** £118
63% Grenache, 20% Cinsault, 12% Syrah, 5% Rolle. The wine displays a pale pink hue, exuding aromas of citrus and pineapple, complemented by subtle hints of spices and herbs. The palate, is rich in flavours of fresh red fruits, including strawberries and raspberries, with a saline finish.

RED WINES

- 56 2023 PETIT VERDOT, Nuit de Lumieres, Philippe Lebrun, Languedoc- Roussillon, France** £46
A deep purple hue with violet undertones. Bold aroma of ripe blackberries and cherries, accented by a refreshing herbal nuance. The palate is vibrant with hints of spice and bay leaves, showcasing a refined texture and elegant tannins. The finish is lengthy and robust, leaving a lasting impression.
- 301 2023 NERO d'AVOLA, Il Folle, Sicily, Italy** £48
The king of Sicilian grapes, that reveals a full-bodied wine with gorgeous aromatics of blackberry liqueur and vanilla.
- 383 2021 CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Los Vascos, Colchagua Valley, Chile** £52
Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafite). A nose of plums and dark cherries with hints of bay leaf and rosemary. The palate is smooth and rounded.
- 400 2020 PINOTAGE, Rhebokskloof, Paarl, South Africa** £56
Aromas of strawberries and ripe raspberries. Elegant texture with soft tannins, acidity which lingers on to the long fruity finish.
- 392 2023 CABERNET FRANC, Cada Nube, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina** £66
A splendid vintage with a bouquet of ripe cherries, blackberries, and a hint of peppery spice. The palate is luscious, featuring fruity notes of blackcurrant and raspberry, complemented by a character of green pepper. This is followed by silky tannins and a vibrant yet elegant acidity.
- 393 2020 CORTE C, Cada Nube, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina** £68
60% Cabernet Franc, 30% Malbec, 10% Merlot. Very ripe and intense dark fruit aromas of black cherry, plum blackberry. In the mouth these characteristics continue together with pencil shavings, herbs and spices. Excellent combination of tannins, acid, body and intensity means this wine is capable of ageing for some time.
- 273 2021 PINOT NOIR, Henri Ehrhart, Ammerschwih, Alsace, France** £78
Aged for 18 months in oak casks, this wine presents a round and harmonious profile. It reveals delicate notes of warm spices and ripe red fruits, which dance gracefully across the palate. The velvety texture is enhanced by expertly integrated tannins, resulting in a smooth and sophisticated drinking experience.
- 46 2022 DUNESFORDE RED, Upper Dunsforth, York, North Yorkshire, England** £90
Grape: 100% Pinot Noir Précoce. This exquisite wine strikes a perfect balance between lightness and complexity. A light wine brimming with vibrant notes of dry cherry, blackberry, and raspberry and a clean and lingering finish.
- 100 2014 Moulin à Vent, Les Rouchaux, Louis Boillot, Burgundy, France** £95
Grape: 100% Gamay. Dark ruby colored wine, with an aromatic fragrance of dark berries, sweet flowers, and hints of Asian spices, complemented by minerality. The palate is sweet and spicy, featuring juicy flavors of black fruits and cherries. The wine is smooth and powerful, yet light-bodied, showcasing a clear finish with soft tannins and a burst of sweet blueberries.
- 300 2020 CHIANTI CLASSICO, Castello Fonterutoli, Tuscany, Italy** £96
Grape: 90% Sangiovese, 5% Malvasia, 5% Colorino. Enticing aromas of violet mingle with luscious dark and red berry notes, complemented by subtle hints of chocolate. This wine presents a medium-bodied, elegant profile, showcasing a robust core of fruit flavours balanced by firm, structured tannins.

RED WINES

- 190 2018 OSCAR TOBIA, Reserva, Rioja Alta, Spain** £98
Grape: 89% Tempranillo, 11% Maturana Tinta. Aged for 31 months. Dried prunes, cherries, liquorice, peppery Spice, cloves, toffee and smoky hints of well integrated oak on the nose while the palate is soft, velvety, and rich with full-bodied and unctuous characters followed by well integrated tannins, spicy notes and a long lasting lingering finish.
- 79 2017 BEAUNE "Les Épenottes", Domaine Machard de Gramont, Burgundy, France** £98
Grape: 100% old vine Pinot Noir. The 2017 vintage, demonstrates bright fruit flavours, soft silky tannins, and a harmonious balance that captures the essence of Burgundy's terroir. The palate is rounded and soft with crushed raspberry and ripe summer berries, supported by elegant tannins and a fresh, earthy finish.
- 304 2021 LE VOLTE, Dell' Ornellaia, Tuscany, Italy** £103
Grape: 50% Merlot, 30% Sangiovese/Brunello, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon. A vibrant ruby red color with purple highlights, offering an aromatic bouquet of lively red fruits and subtle spice notes. On the palate, this well-balanced wine harmoniously combines smooth tannins with refreshing acidity.
- 390 2012 QUIMERA, BORDEAUX BLEND, Achaval-Ferrer, Mendoza, Argentina** £104
48% Malbec, 19% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Cabernet Franc, 13% Merlot, 2% Petit Verdot. Sweet tobacco, blueberries, cedar, rosemary, liquorice and violets aromas. The palate is juicy with dense tannins and Savoury Finish.
- 224 2021 SAINT-JULIEN, AOC Saint-Julien, Grand Vin De Bordeaux, Maison Sichel, France** £105
50% Merlot, 50% Cabernet Sauvignon. Hints of blackcurrant, raspberry and spice. The palate is well-structured, with silky, creamy tannins.
- 442 2018 SANGUINE ESTATE, Heathcote, Victoria, Australia** £116
100% Shiraz/Syrah. Rich and aromatic with aromas of black fruits and vanillin oak. 24 months in oak add complexity. The palate is rich and long with blackberry, plum, liquorice, and blueberry fruits, fennel and peppery spice. Black fruits, Silky tannins, youthfulness and depth with a long expressive finish.
- 219 2003 CHÂTEAU LES ORMES-DE-PEZ, Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel, St-Estephe, Bordeaux, France** £118
65% cabernet sauvignon, 20% merlot, 15% cabernet franc. Fruity and complex nose with hints of liquorice, plum and spicy characters.
- 216 2014 CHÂTEAU L'ÉVÊCHÉ, Grand Cru, Saint-Emilion, Bordeaux, France** £122
80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc. The wine is, soft, round, medium-bodied and easy to drink, with ripe cherries and plums notes.
- 208 2010 CHÂTEAU SOCIANDO-MALLET, Cru Bourgeois, Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux, France** £128
55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot and 5% Cabernet Franc. Cassis, black berries, chocolate, cherries, sweet spices, vanilla and a touch of cedar. The wine is sweet mid-palate with a savoury finish.

The 2018 vintage boasts a complex, intense nose of exotic spices, violets, lavender and fresh, ripe fruits like black cherries, plums and blueberries. On the palate, it presents great body, structure and harmony, with a fulfilling, slightly sweet entry from ripe, velvety tannins. The wine's fleshy, meaty texture is complemented by fine tannins and well-integrated acidity. Its dark colour, ripe fruit flavours, silky tannins and long finish, with hints of vanilla, chocolate and blonde tobacco, suggest excellent ageing potential.

The bouquet offers aromas of dark berries, liquorice, freshly tanned leather, and dark spices. The palate is rich and full-bodied, presenting flavours of rum and raisin dark chocolate, liquorice, quince paste, and dried fruits. The structure is robust, featuring prominent yet well-integrated tannins.
- 220 1994 CHÂTEAU LATOUR, premier Grand cru classé, Pauillac, Bordeaux, France** £2,350
68% Cabernet Sauvignon, 27% Merlot, 4% Cabernet Franc, and 1% Petit Verdot. 94 points Robert Parker. Opaque with a dark ruby-purple hue appearance and an intense aromatic profile of walnut, cassis, smoky toasted bread, plums, and cherries. The body is full with robust dark fruit flavours of blackcurrant, liquorice, tar, and tobacco culminate in a juicy, well-structured, lengthy finish and sweet tannins.
- 208 1981 PETRVS, Grand Vin, Pomerol, Bordeaux, France** £2,850
96% Merlot, 4% Cabernet Franc. 89 points Robert Parker. Aged for 20 months in new French oak. Delicate wild strawberry notes mingle with subtle hints of tobacco leaf and graphite in this understated vintage. The palate presents a lighter style, as anticipated, with vegetal characters, coffee, cherry fruits, and spicy oak nuances. A fine balance of vigour and substance.
